SPEED WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

We have the pleasure to inform you that the Speed Skating World Championships 2025 -for Junior & Senior categories: Track, Road and Marathon- will be held in the city of Beidaihe, People's Republic of China, from September 13th to 21st, 2025.

OFFICIAL WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP RACES

Track:

200m Dual Time Trial
500m +D Sprint
1.000m Sprint
3.000m Relay
5.000m Points
10.000m Elimination

Road:

100m Sprint
One Lap Sprint
10.000m Points
15.000m Elimination

Marathon:

42,195km

COUNTRY QUOTA

The maximum skaters registration number per National Team per category for **Track** and **Road** races is as follows:

- **Senior men:** 8 skaters
- **Senior women:** 8 skaters
- **Junior men:** 8 skaters
- **Junior women:** 8 skaters

Please note that:

- Only 2 skaters per National Team may take part in each race.
- Either 3 or 4 skaters per National Team may be registered in the Relay Race.
- For the Marathon race, there is only one (1) category per gender: one for Women & one for Men. All registered skaters to Track or Road races per National Federation are allowed to participate.


LOCATION

Beidaihe District, under the jurisdiction of Qinhuangdao City, Hebei Province, is located in the northeast of Hebei Province and the southeast of Qinhuangdao City. It borders the Bohai Sea to the east and south, and is adjacent to Funing District to the west and north, and adjacent to Haigang District to the northeast. The events will take place in the following locations:

- **Track & Road Circuit:** Beidaihe International Roller Skating Center

REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

All registrations will be made through the World Skate Infinity Platform. The dates and procedures will be communicated in the following bulletin.

ENTRY FEES

The fee entries are as follows:

- 400 USD for each country participating at the Championships
- 100 USD for each Senior skater entered for the Track Championships
- 100 USD for each Senior skater entered for the Road Championships
- 50 USD for each Junior skater entered for the Track Championships
- 50 USD for each Junior skater entered for the Road Championships

JUDGES EXAMINATION SESSION

During the World Championships, it will be organized an Examination Session for those national judges who wish to access an international level. More information to be released in the next bulletin.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International

Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024 and 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.


GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS
